Gospel of John – Chapter Six

(32) Jesus then said to them. . . my Father gives you the true bread from heaven.

(33) For **the bread of God** is that which comes down from heaven, and gives life to the world." (34) They said to him, "Lord, give us **this bread** always."

#1 35 Jesus said to them, "**I am the bread of life**; he who comes to me shall not hunger, and he who believes in me shall never thirst. . . .

#2 (41) The Jews then murmured at him, because he said, "I am the **bread** which came down from heaven." (42) They said, "Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How does he now say, 'I have come down from heaven'?"
(43) Jesus answered them, "Do not murmur among yourselves. . . .

#3 (47) Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes has eternal life. (48) **I am the bread of life**. (49) Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died.

#4 (50) **This is the bread** which comes down from heaven, that a man may eat of it and not die.

#5 (51) **I am the living bread** which came down from heaven; if any one eats of **this bread**, he will live for ever; and **the bread which I shall give for**
I **for** the life of the world **is my flesh**."

(52) The Jews then disputed among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?"

II (53) So Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the **flesh of the Son of man and drink his blood**, you have no life in you;

III (54) he who **eats my flesh and drinks my blood** has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.

IV (55) **For my flesh is food indeed, and my blood is drink** indeed.

V (56) He who **eats my flesh and drinks my blood** abides in me, and I in him.

VI (57) As the living Father sent me, and I live because of the Father, so **he who eats me will live because of me**.

VII (58) This is the bread which came down from heaven, not such as the fathers ate and died; he who eats **this bread** will live for ever."

(59) This he said in the synagogue, as he taught at Capernaum.
